**Greater Pensacola USBC Association - Youth 11<sup>th</sup> Annual City Tournament**  
**November 5 & 6 2016 at New Liberty Lanes**

1. Certified by USBC. GPUSBCA Youth Tournament rules and regulations will prevail.
2. Entry into Youth City Tournament will be open to GPUSBCA Youth members in good standing.
3. Entering average for each bowler will be determined by the following priority: Highest 2015 - 2016 GPUSBCA bowl.com average; then Highest 2016-2017 GPUSBCA Youth certified league average as of entry deadline (October 31, 2016), minimum of 12 games; bowlers without any of the above qualifications will bowl scratch.
4. **All entries must be received by the Tournament Director, by Sunday, October 31, 2016.** All entries will be numbered and scheduled as presented to the tournament director. All fees must accompany the entry. **All fees must be paid by league check, certified check, cashiers check or money order, made payable to the GPUSBCA Events. DO NOT SEND CASH.**
5. After entries have been received, and the dates assigned and not refused by the team or individual entrant, and the schedule is prepared, no fees will be returned.
6. Total entry fee will be \$11.00 per bowler per event: Bowling fee \$7.50, Award fee \$3.00, and Scholarship fund \$0.50.
7. All divisions will be handicapped based on 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 200.
8. The tournament will be conducted on an average basis in five divisions (divisions will be combined if too few entrants are in a division), regardless of the age of the bowlers.
9. Events will be, Teams (4 members), Singles, Doubles and All Events. Teams and Doubles may be composed of any combination of boys and girls.
10. Multiple participation is permitted in the Team and Doubles events only. Bowlers may enter team event three times with no more than two of the original members per team. No more than two players can place once in the position standings. The first team event bowled will be counted as all events entry score.
11. Bowlers entered in Doubles must enter in Singles. Bowlers entered in Singles must enter in Doubles. Bowlers may enter Singles events only once. Bowlers may enter doubles event two times but **MUST** have a different partner each time. The first doubles event bowled will be counted as all events entry score.
12. Doubles event will be bowled first, followed by Singles. In the event that a doubles partner is not present at the beginning of the Doubles a substitute may be provided, or 0 will be given for the absent bowler.
13. All bowlers will bowl three games on a pair of lanes per event. Doubles and Singles will be bowled on the same pair of lanes (With the exception of lane breakdown). If breakdown occurs, the Tournament Director has the authority to reassign lanes.
14. In case of a tie for first place Co - Champions will be declared and duplicate awards will be presented.
15. Any bowlers arriving after the squad starts will start bowling in the frame currently being bowled. No score will be recorded for frames missed.
16. No blind scores will be permitted. A bowler must bowl at the same time and on the same lanes as their team is bowling.
17. If any protest occurs during the game, the game must be stopped and the protest resolved at that time. Any appeal to a protest decision must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours. (USBC Rule 329)
18. Bowlers guilty of misconduct may be disqualified from the tournament at the discretion of Tournament Officials.
19. Youth bowlers are not permitted to play video/pinball or any other games while participating in the tournament No cell phones, MP3/iPods or any other Electronic gadgets permitted.
20. Tobacco products or alcoholic beverages are **NOT** allowed in the presence of the Youth Bowlers.
21. **Appropriate** bowler's attire will be worn. No hats/bandanas, halter/tank tops, short shorts or clothing with tobacco/alcohol advertising or profane/derogatory language. Underwear must **not** be visible. The Tournament Director will handle violations.
22. USBC Youth Rule 400 will apply to all tournament participants.
23. Tournament recaps will be the official score and will be retained for a year.
24. Entry form information must be typed or printed and must be verified by an active league coach. Coaches will be responsible for the correct spelling of all names on the entry form. Team names or abbreviations deemed improper by tournament officials, will be changed.
25. Check in time will be 30 minutes prior to bowling. **Substitutes must check in 45 minutes prior to bowling.**
26. Teams and Doubles will bowl in the order listed on the entry form. Teams bowling out of order **will** be disqualified. Team captains are responsible to ensure the team line-up is correct.
27. No changes or corrections to scoring will be entered by tournament bowlers. Tournament officials or lane monitors will enter all corrections.
28. Substitutes may be used and will replace the absent bowler in that line-up position. Once a substitute has rolled their first ball in tournament play that person will become the legal bowler in that event. Averages for substitutes must be verified by league coaches and submitted to the Tournament Director no later than 24 hours after completion of the tournament, otherwise scratch scores will apply.
29. For Singles and All Events only, divisions will include separate boys and girls competition for awards.
30. The award fund will be returned 100%. A minimum of one award per five entries will be given. One award will be given for first place Scratch for each event, in each division.
31. Coaching, by coaches, will be allowed between frames and only on the concourse. **No adults (coaches or parents) will be allowed in the bowling circle. Tournament officials and lane monitors being the only exception.**
32. Bowlers must not leave the bowling area without notifying a Tournament Official.
