

- Monthly breast self-exams, yearly clinical exams and annual mammography are all keys to early detection of breast cancer. Visit koman.org/bse for an online breast self-examination instructional tool. The Web site provides breast self-exam instruction through video animation, audio clips and written directions in both English and Spanish.
- This year an estimated 178,480 new cases of invasive breast cancer among women are expected to be diagnosed.
- Over 40,000 women and men are expected to die of breast cancer this year.
- Breast cancer is the most common type of cancer among women today.
