Youth Doubles Tournament Rules

This is a handicap tournament.

1. **Eligibility** - All entrants must be Youth members of the Greater Pensacola USBC Association in good standing. USBC Tournament Rules and Regulations will govern this tournament.
2. **Averages** - All contestants will use their highest 2017-2018 GPUSBCA January 1st sanctioned league average of 21 or more league games. Bowlers without a January 1st average of 21 or more games will use their average of 21 or more games as of Entries Closing Date March 19, 2018. If none, highest 2016-2017 GPUSBCA year book average of 21 or more games. Bowlers with none of the above averages will bowl scratch. **League Coaches must submit written verification of the USBC Youth Bowlers Average.** Rule 319A-2, "10 Pin Rule" **IS IN EFFECT** and is based on Jan. 1, 2018 averages.
3. **Handicap** – All Divisions will be handicapped based on 90% the difference between the bowler's average and 200. A right-handed bowler with an established right-handed average must bowl right-handed. Similarly, a left-handed average bowler must bowl left-handed. USBC Rules allow a bowler that uses the two-handed approach to alternate their release between a two-handed approach and one handed delivery provided the same hand is being used to impart equal force or impetus to the ball for all deliveries.
4. **Divisions** – This tournament will be conducted on an average basis in five division, regardless of the age of the bowler.
5. **Multiple Participation** - Bowlers may participate up to two (2) times with a different doubles partner. Doubles may be composed of any combination of boys and girls.
6. **Entries** - All entries and fees must be in the hands of the Tournament Manager no later than March 19, 2018. The entry fee is \$11.00 per person, per entry. **All fees must be payable to the GPUSBCA Youth Leaders. DO NOT SEND CASH!**
7. **Scheduling / Bowling Order** – Bowlers will bowl in the assigned squads in the order listed on the Entry Form. Anyone bowling out of order WILL be disqualified.
8. **Protests** - If any protest occurs during the game, the game must be stopped and the protest resolved at that time. Any appeal to protest decision must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours.
9. **Check-in** - **All bowlers should check-in at the tournament table 45 minutes prior to scheduled bowling time.** Any player or doubles pair arriving late shall begin play with the score counting, beginning with the frame then being bowled. No blind scores will be used. No scores will be recorded for frames missed.
10. **Substitutes** – Substitutes may be used and will replace the absent bowler in the line-up position. Once a substitute has rolled their first ball in tournament play, that person will become the legal bowler in the event. Averages for substitutes must be verified by league coaches and submitted to the Tournament Manager no later than 24 hours after completion of the tournament, otherwise scratch scores will apply.
11. **Official Score** – All games/series scores will be recorded on official tournament recap sheets.
12. **Ties** – In the case of a tie for First place, Co-Champions will be declared and duplicate awards will be presented.
13. **Prizes** – All prize funds will be returned 100%. A ratio of 1 place for every 10 entries per division, plus a first-place scratch award in each division.
14. **Management** – The Tournament Manager shall have the authority to decide matters pertaining to the operation of this tournament.
15. **Bowlers Conduct** - Bowlers guilty of misconduct may be disqualified from the tournament at the discretion of the Tournament Manager. USBC Youth bowlers are not permitted to use tobacco products, play video/pinball games or drink alcoholic beverages while participating in the tournament. **NO CELL PHONES or Electronic devices** are permitted.
16. **Tournament Dress Code** - **While competing, proper attire is required. No halter/tank tops, short shorts, swimsuits, hats or spandex. Underwear must NOT be visible. All shirts must have sleeves. NO OBSCENE ATTIRE. Any issues about proper attire will be decided upon by the Tournament Management.**
